









Scenic Beauty and Environment:

- Waitai Station features stunning coastal landscapes, with rugged cliffs, pristine beaches, and lush native bush with tracks to walk or bike.
- The surrounding waters are teeming with marine life making it an ideal spot for fishing, diving, snorkelling, kayaking and exploring.
- The island is home to a variety of bird species, including Bell Birds, South Island Robins, Black Fantails, Wekas, Pukekos and the NZ Falcon to name a few.
- The quiet in this remote location offers respite.
- Sea Spray Cottage provides accommodation for those seeking a tranquil escape.

Location:

- D'Urville Island lies in the Marlborough Sounds off the northern end of the South Island. It is one of the larger Islands in New Zealand and has a population of 52 permanent residents.
- Situated on the northern part of the island, Waitai Station is comprised of over 2000 hectares of naturally regenerating native bush.

Heritage and History:

- D'Urville Island has a rich history including early Maori settlement and European exploration.
